This quick start guide provides simplified instructions for interfacing the A0344 Sage gas autosampler with Picarro CRDS analyzers. Note this guide is not a replacement for the Picarro Sage or the appropriate CRDS analyzer's user manuals. Picarro recommends reading the manuals provided on the USB drive before proceeding.

Getting Started

Before setting up and using your new Sage gas autosampler, please ensure your Picarro CRDS analyzer is set up correctly. Refer to the CRDS analyzer's user manual for instructions.

1. Install the hose fitting to the A2000 pump, set the appropriate voltage, and power it on.




NOTE: To continue the installation procedure of the Sage gas autosampler, refer to the following port and connection diagrams on the next page.

- 2. For electrical connections use the **POWER** and **USB** on the back of the Sage autosampler using the supplied power and USB cables. Note a power adapter must be used and any available USB port on the CRDS analyzer can be used for communication.
- Gas line connections are made using the supplied tubing and Sage autosampler's SAMPLE and FLUSH ports. This includes the output and purge lines and ZA/N₂ gas. See the autosampler port and connection diagrams on the next page.
- 4. Install the Picarro Sage software from the included USB drive onto your CRDS analyzer's computer. Note it is only needed if the Sage autosampler is purchased separately.
